### **Minutes**

**April 19, 2016**

### **INTERNET PROGRESS**

Allen reported that the primary source for internet service has been laid from the City Hall basement for two blocks north to the Studebaker Garage. We are waiting for Spectrum Online to return and complete that section of the project.

The quarterly report has been completed and sent to the Economic Development keeping them "up to speed" on the progress of our internet project. At this point no money from the grant we received from the EDC has been spent.

Josh has contacted Bob Iverson of Spectrum about providing WiFi along Third Street during the Car Show/Cruisin Days on May 21<sup>st</sup>. The PDA felt this would be a nice service for visitors as well as a way to promote the service soon to be available through the efforts of the PDA grant.

Those present discussed the need for various services in our community. A food service/coffee shop ranked high on the PDA needs list.

The next meeting will be May 17<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm at the Golf Club Café if arrangements can be made with the personnel at the Golf Club. Josh will notify the members when he has the information.
