

**Harrington Public Development Authority**  
**Minutes**  
**May 16, 2017**

The monthly meeting of the Public Development Authority (PDA) was called to order at 7:02pm on May 16, 2017 by President Josh Steward. Those present were: Josh Steward, Allen Barth, Tim Tipton, Paul Charlton, Heather Slack and Bunny Haugan. Jay Kane has excused absences as he is in Seattle recouping from a fall.

A motion by Allen Barth and second by Paul Charlton approved the minutes as presented. Motion carried.

The treasurer reported a bank balance of \$603.39 in the checking account. A bill for \$118.80 was paid to Parks Print for 250 tourist brochures. The new tourist brochure as well as a new brochure completed by the City listing information helpful to new residence coming into the community was reviewed and met with approval. The flyer completed by Margie Hall (EDC) advertising the high speed internet for businesses along Third Street with information on connection charges and fees was available for review.

WiFi accessibility for the up-coming car show is a high priority. Josh will contact Spectrum Online and talk to Bob Iverson about having it available for May 20<sup>th</sup>.

**ELECTION**

The election of a president was new business. Josh Steward's four year term was up for election and Josh chose not to run again. A motion by Bunny and second by Paul nominated the names of Allen Barth for President and Heather Slack for Vice President. Allen accepted the nomination for President. It was necessary for him to resign his position as Vice President and Heather accept the nomination of Vice President. The motion carried.

The discussion about signage for the Car Show/Cruisin Harrington followed. It was felt a specific sign for the car show would advertise the event better and putting the sign on private property on highway 28 would make it visible to travelers. It was agreed to put it on the agenda for 2018 and address it again at that time.

There was a short discussion about a program at the Opera House featuring Peter Davenport and the UFO events. Peter has been the guest speaker for past events he did for the PDA. He has consented to contact two other speakers he has heard and arrange with them to present an event at the Opera House. We will stay in touch with him and work with the Opera House.
