Alumni Scholarships Cross a Spectrum of Ages

Due to your generous response to Colin Fitzpatrick's challenge for donations to the Alumni Scholarship Fund, we were able to give four High School Scholarships and four Continuing Education Scholarships. And, in addition, to help future students be prepared, a \$500 scholarship for a State Library Grant six week Summer School in Harrington (2017) for any students ages 6-12

Four graduating Seniors each received a \$500 Alumni scholarship during the High School graduation ceremony on June 9.

Riley Bradford: She will be attending Spokane Falls Community College in the fall to prepare for WSU and a career as a Crime Scene Investigator.
