Who: Open to applicants ages 6-13. Limited to the **First 30** applicants.

What: The *Stimulating Summers: Enriching Young Lives* Summer Day Camp Program will provide a structured recreational learning environment for Youth ages 6-13 from 8am to 5pm beginning July 3rd through August 11th, 2017. The Summer Camp will participate in the Harrington Summer Feeding Program which will provide a morning snack and lunch, and local library program.

When: Six weekly programs will be offered from 8am to 5pm beginning July 3rd and ending August 11th. (No programming on July 4th) Youth may be registered for one or all six weeks.

Where: The *Stimulating Summers: Enriching Young Lives* Day Camp will be based out of the Harrington School Multi-purpose room, but will move about the community to utilize the city park and city library. Parents will drop off and pick up their youth in the school multi-purpose room. Enter through the North side door. (pool entrance)

Cost: \$50.00 /week. (Financial aid available to those who qualify.)

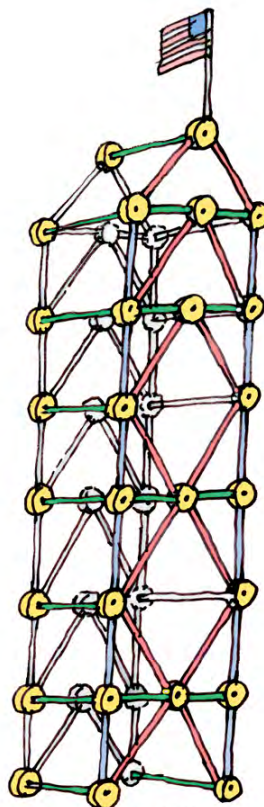
